

COLLEGE REPORT 2008-09

Madam

It is my privilege to present before you the Annual College Report 2008-09 of Government College of Commerce & Business Administration Sector 42 Chandigarh.

ABOUT THE COLLEGE:

Government College of Commerce & Business Administration (GCCBA) is the first exclusive college in Chandigarh dealing with extensive study of Commerce and Management Education in Chandigarh. Approval to start this college was granted by His Excellency General (Retd) S.F. Rodrigues, the Governor of Punjab and Administrator, U.T.Chandigarh, on September 15, 2006. After granting of affiliation by Panjab University, 140 students were admitted in B.Com I and 45 students were admitted in B.B.A I for the academic session 2007-2008. On February 19, 2008 the inspection committee team appointed by Panjab University granted affiliation of B.Com II & B.B.A II for the academic session 2008-2009. Presently, there are 377 students on roll.

FACULTY:

The present Principal, Dr. Shyam Sunder took over the charge on January 1, 2009. A doctorate in Hindi, he has served in different local government colleges as lecturer and dean.

The College boasts of highly qualified and well trained teaching faculty. Of the total 18 faculty members, 5 have been appointed on regular basis whereas 10 lecturers have been appointed on contractual basis and 3 are guest faculty.

Three of the faculty members are P.hd's, while two have done M.Phil. Two members are pursuing their P.hd while one is doing M.Phil.

UNIVERSITY RESULTS 2007-08:

Even though we are a fledgling college, our first batch of students performed commendably in the P.U. Annual Exams 2007-08. The College pass percentage was 100 % for B.B.A.I as against the university pass percentage of 67.60% whereas B.Com I pass percentage was 98% as against university pass percentage of 70.67%.

INFRASTRUCTURE:

The College is presently operating from temporarily allotted building in Sector-42. It has 6 classrooms, 8 tutorial rooms, 1 computer laboratory in addition to library, administrative office, Principal office and staff-room.

Computer Laboratory

The college has a state of the art computer lab consisting of 20 computers accessible to staff and students.

The administrative office, Principal office, staff room, and library also have internet facility.

• Library

GCCBA Library has a modern open shelf system catering to the information needs of the students and the faculty of the college. Textbooks, reference books, general books, journals/periodicals and non-book materials like DVD- ROM, CD-ROM etc are acquired regularly. During the year 2007-2008, 760 books worth Rs 2,66,056 lacs have been purchased.

The Library uses **Libsys software package** which is an integrated multi-user library management system that supports all in-house operations of the Library.Retrospective conversion of bibliographic records has been completed and all bibliographic records of books available in the library can now be accessed through the **Libsys OPAC**. **OPAC** enables searches to be conducted with ease and speed.

Library is equipped with 1 server with network printer, bar code printer, barcode reader and internet.
