GCCBA is the only college in Chandigarh dealing exclusively with the streams of commerce and management. Approval to start the college was granted by His Excellency, General (Redt.) S. F. Rodrigues, the then Governor of Punjab, and Administrator, U.T. Chandigarh in Sept 2006. This college was a dream child of the then DHE Mrs. Raji P. Srivastva and Prof. Pahlad Aggarwal, Deputy Director Higher Education. The team of Prof. Bhupinder Singh (Founder Principal), Dr. Rosy Walia and Mr. Amarpreet Singh as founder lecturers and Mr. Balkishan Sharma as administrative office incharge undertook the mammoth task of starting the new professional college from scratch. After granting of affiliation by Panjab University, the first academic session 2007-08 was started with 185 students. Presently there are **553** students on roll.
