ABOUT THE COLLEGE

Government College of Commerce and Business Administration (GCCBA) is the only college in Chandigarh dealing exclusively with the streams of commerce and management. Approval to start the college was granted by His Excellency, General (Retd) S. F. Rodrigues, the then Governor of Punjab, and Administrator, UT Chandigarh in September 2006. This college was a dream child of Professor Pahlad Aggarwal, the then Deputy Director Higher Education of Chandigarh Administration who with the help of Sh. G. L. Kashyap, Finance and Planning Officer, prepared the project report. But it was the then Director Higher Education Mrs Raji P. Srivastava, who initiated the move to the administration. The trailblazing team of Professor Bhupinder Singh as the founder principal, Dr Rosy Walia and Mr Amarpreet Singh as founder lecturers and Mr Bal Krishan Sharma as administrative office in-charge undertook the mammoth task of starting the new professional college from scratch. What you see today is the flowering of the seeds sown by them.

After grant of affiliation by Panjab University, the first academic session (2007–08) commenced with 185 students. Presently, there are 564 students on roll who are being offered the following courses under Panjab University as Bachelor in Commerce, Bachelor in Commerce (Honours), and Bachelor in Business Administration.

ACADEMICS

UNIVERSITY EXAMINATION RESULTS

We may be a college in its infancy, but very commendably our students have shown appreciable performance in the Annual University Examination of 2013, with pass percentage much higher than that of the University pass percentage and we achieved 100% results in B.B.A III, B.Com

III, 98% in B.B.A II, 95% in B.Com II and B.Com I which is much above the university pass percentage.

Ms Parul Jain got **fifth position in overall Panjab University Merit List for B.Com I** and is the only student amongst all the colleges of Chandigarh to have found a place in the merit list. Sonam of our college got **eleventh position in overall Panjab University Merit List for B.B.A III**.

THE ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE

Mr Anil Kumar heads the administrative team comprising of Mr Balwinder Singh (Junior Assistant) and Mr Naresh Kumar (Clerk) along with the team of 03 members against additional sanctioned posts ensures the smooth functioning of the office. Assisting in the maintenance of the institution are 07 Class III, 17 Class IV and 01 Class II employees who are dedicated to the swift performance of Administrative task of the college.

Ms Amrit Kaur, who had been a Clerk of the college, joined as Junior Assistant at IIT, Ropar, Punjab in September 2013 whose position was then replaced by Ms Pritbir Kaur, who joined the college in January 2014.

FEE CONCESSION/ SCHOLARSHIP

The underprivileged and bright students are offered various incentives by the college. Tuition-fee concession (50 per cent) has been awarded to 26 students. The cases of Post Metric Scholarship for meritorious students have been moved to the university and the administration. The confirmation is still awaited.

INFRASTRUCTURE

The college is presently operating from a temporarily allotted donated building in Sector 42. In addition to ten smart classrooms, the college has a computer laboratory, an enriched library, an administrative office, a principal's office, and a staff room. Landscaping and beautification of the campus has recently been undertaken and it presents a pleasant spectacle.

A 50 KW Solar Panel was started in the college campus. The system is linked up with the service provider on a 24 hour basis for which the internet and server of the college run on a 24 hour basis. The college implemented the E-Governance solutions for the management of the various activities of the college. The solution is called Campus Solution, wherein the modules like admission, subject allocation, examination and fees have been implemented. The IT department successfully launched and implemented 24 hour availability of internet and campus solutions software availability in the campus.

CLASS ROOMS

Keeping pace with the modern techno-savvy world, our college is having smart classrooms with a view to provide comforting atmosphere to make learning more focused and effective. Our classrooms are stuffed with multifarious facilities such as Air condition, Smart Digital Podiums attached with a Computer, LAN and Internet connectivity to encourage online and research based teaching. Other fittings include Multimedia Projectors, Wall mounted high grain screens and wooden dual desks of the latest design and ergonomics are provided to the students for their ease and comfort.

SEMINAR ROOMS

The college takes pride in having a very well equipped, fully air-conditioned and acoustically well maintained Seminar Room which is a part of the ultra-modern infrastructure with state-of-the-art, audio-visual, and presentation tools to facilitate smooth presentations and seminars to help students develop their soft skills. It has witnessed many artistic, academic and cultural activities being hosted by the college throughout the year. Eminent speakers and other noted personalities have been visiting the college and sharing their pool of knowledge, wisdom and skill set with the students and faculty in the form of lectures, debates, discussions, and workshops. It adds as a facilitator for the effective delivery of our curriculum.

STAFF ROOMS

We have a well-equipped, fully air-conditioned and well maintained staff room with ultra-modern facilities to provide our staff members a comforting and conducive environment so that they can use their potentialities to the fullest.

LIBRARY

Our library is very resourcefully run by DrAmarnath Sharma and his library staff. The Library is set up in modernized platform and caters to the information needs of the students, faculty and

staff member of the college. The Library has a collection of 2598 documents which including textbooks, reference books, general books and non-book materials. The Library subscribes about 25 Magazines/Journals and 15 newspaper. Total collection of the library is 2598(Reference books – 237; Textbooks 1394; General books 926 and Unique title – 41)

Information searching service: Library staff is helping faculty and students by searching online/offline information requested by them. Library staff uses available information resources and Open Access journals/databases to explore requested information.
